4. Bicyclists Bill of Rights: The members are developing guiding principals for the BAC based on the Bill of Rights and a discussion was held regarding the recent Council motion introduced by Council member Rosendahl to formally adopt the principals for the City.

6. Bicycle Licensing LAMC: No new information regarding consideration of a repeal of the ordinance by City Council.
