1. Members in Attendance: Kent Strumpell, Paul Backstrom, Alex Baum, Larry Hoffman, and Aubrey Provost.
2. Review and Adoption of Minutes – Tabled to next meeting.
3. NBC Universal Master Plan – City Planning staff as well as staff from the Universal planning process to discuss the status of the Universal Master Plan, EIR and the entitlement process. A discussion was held, and questions asked, about the status of the bike path on the LAR and the infeasibility of the bikeways being presented by Universal in the plan.

One general public comment made on the Universal Master Plan.

4. Bicycle Plan Update – Overall work on the draft policy document and mapping is ongoing by staff and Alta. The consulting team has begun the process for the mountain bike forum, which includes identifying key groups in the equestrian, hiking and mountain bicycling community to provide representatives who will meet to discuss the potential for the inclusion of mountain bicycling in City parks.

Five public comments made; primarily opposing mountain bicycling in City parks.

5. Exposition Light Rail Phase II LRT Bikeway – A discussion was held about the progress of the bikeway element of LRT project. Staff is engaging in meetings with the Expor Authority and Metro to discuss funding and obstacles to building both projects together. The LACBC has been conducting an outreach in support of the bikeway.
6. Meter Post Conversion Pilot Project – An update of the project provided by staff.
7. Wayfinding Signage – Joseph Prichard provided a presentation about progressive bikeway signage.
