8. Bikeways Report – Bikeways Engineer, Michael May, provided information on the Chandler Bike Path maintenance issues and theft of copper wire along the Los Angeles which has disabled the lighting system.

9. Public Comments – Two public comments were submitted requesting personal contact information for BAC members and questioning the city's data collection for bicycle collisions.

10. BAC Member Comments – Ron Skarin noted that Tana Ball’s Safety program had not received ongoing funding and Chairman Alex Baum provided a status report on Officer Bruce Christianson who’s recently underwent shoulder surgery and is now expected to return to active duty in two months.
